OFFICER POSITIONS

◆ PRESIDENT: Shall call and conduct general meetings; shall create ad hoc committees as needed; shall represent the Society to the university, graduate school, Real Estate

department administration, and to all non-university bodies; shall act as chairman of the executive committee; and shall appoint all parliamentarian.

- ❖ VICE PRESIDENT: Shall perform the function of the President during the incapacity of the President or when delegated by the President to do so; shall serve as the liaison between the Society and the University Student Government; and shall serve on the executive committee.
